## CITY CLERK REPORT

Minutes from February council meeting. Minutes are posted on the City of Elmdale website.

February Reconciliation printout was given to each member.

Monthly checks to Mark Davis and Sheryle Baker will be paid on March 29<sup>th</sup>.

Double D Mowing done a great job on the lagoon cleanup. Trees were removed and cells 1 & 2 were cleaned up. The quote for \$4000.78 was presented to the council. Cell 3 will be burned at a later date.

A motion was made, seconded, and voted on and accepted. The check for \$4000.78 was sent out on March 12, for a job well done. The lagoon will be redone twice a year to keep it in good condition.

Double D is also working to put the fence back in shape per State.

Double D will send a quote for the city streets.

Matthew is our Operator in Training. A motion was made, seconded and voted on and accepted by Council to pay for the certification in the amount of \$1000 for classes and tests.

A motion was made for the purchase of a Dyna Fog Fogger Series 3 for \$500.

Chemicals for the lagoon treatment and mosquito control will be purchased through MARC Mid America Research Chemical.

Jim will continue with the mowing and a motion was made, seconded and approved for the purchase of an air compressor \$300 and a weed eater \$300 for the City Shop.

There was a break-in at City Hall and 5 window panes were broken out. The replacement of 6 panes as another is broken was \$82.02. Floor jacks and boards are ready when we get help, to secure floor in kitchen The appliances and stoves in the City Hall are no longer viable and we are discussing the sale of them to help with our restoration of City Hall.

A lead & copper survey was sent out with the March water bill, and residents will return surveys by August 2024 for inventory sheet to be sent in per the EPA

Jim has said that he will help with the 220 wiring for ac/heat unit as the Council has declared 220 wiring was selected as best for our City Hall. The cost of the AC/Heat unit is \$620 and 50' of 220 wiring is \$126. This was tabled for April.

Motion to pay March bills and seconded.
