DISCUSSIONS

The discussion was made that we will have to actually have a town meeting before we make a decision as this affects all of the residents. On December 15, 2021, the City of Elmdale withdrew from the National Flood Insurance Plan. The letter is included in a separate file.

The letter from FEMA states we are not eligible for federal grants for water lines or wastewater treatment lift station. We have filed pre-applications for both and will wait to see what the outcome will be,

Scott Wilse talked with Theresa about a radio transmitter for the fire siren. No decision has been made as yet.

Discussion for trail cams for the City Hall and City Fire Station/Shop was decided that it is the city's best interest to put up these trail cams in light of the recent break-in and breaking of the windows at City Hall and the new equipment at the City Shop.

A motion was made and seconded for trail cams.

Double D Mowing, Inc will mow the Lagoon twice a year for \$1,000. Council approved

The city street project will go forward as soon as we put together a budget to proceed.

2 whistles will be put in at Elm & Spruce and Grand & Spruce at the cost of \$350 per whistle.
