FEMA Mitigation - Scott Wilse said the benefits of FEMA in case of a breach of the dike.

He is also talking to Jerry Moran's office to get funding for a fire siren. The siren will be moved to a pole behind the public restrooms as the siren is no located on private property and would be monitored by the Sheriff's office by a radio signal.

Matthew's report on the Chlorinator there are still issues being addressed.

We are still under a boil water advisory until further notice!!

We received a bid for \$700.00 for the electrical for ac/heat unit to be run in City Hall.

We received an estimate for the repairing of the doors and windows for \$7.200.00. I will be trying to secure grants to help with this project. I have applied for a grant from the Chase County Community Fund to help with these issues. I will report when I hear from the committee.

Matthew brought up the idea of a Pancake Breakfast once a month. Any more interest in this idea. It was decided to wait on this, until a further date.

DISCUSSION

FEMA Mitigation is still NO, as the only benefit would be if there was a breach at the dike.

Double D has finished the roads, and we really appreciate that. The cost of \$5,862.00 has been paid from the Special Highway Fund. The balance for the roads will be paid as soon as we receive the invoice.

KDHE sent a letter stating that we have a categorical exclusion for the \$900,000 for our water lines.

We will have interest for the water lines, to pay on the loan for the lift station; so we are waiting for this to be ironed out with KDHE, Still don't know how much interest it will be.
